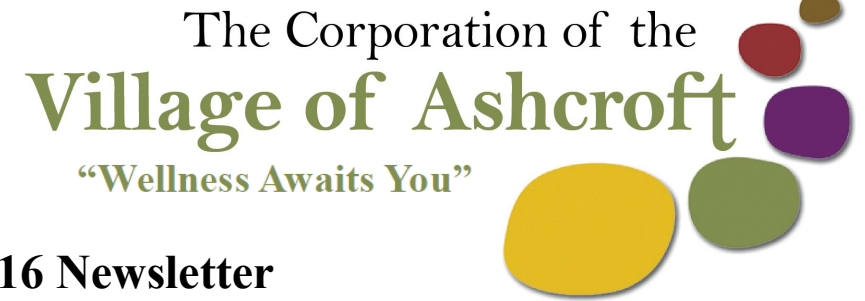

## Community Update

Mayor Jeyes and Council would like to take a few minutes of your time to tell you about a number of things they have been working on as well as some community events:

- Proclamation: The Council proclaims 'National Tourism Week' from May 29th to June 4th.
- Proclamation: The Council proclaims 'Access Awareness Day' on June 4th.
- Yoriko Susanj, Executive Director of the South Cariboo Elizabeth Fry, presented to Council about their public produce and community garden project. She also gave an update on the services that the organization provides.
- The Village provided a \$500 grant in aid to the Ashcroft HUB to help offset the cost of an Aquafit program at the Ashcroft pool.
- The Village of Ashcroft renewed their annual operating agreement with BC Transit for the continued operation of the local para-transit system.
- Council adopted the '5 Year Financial Plan' and 'Tax Rates' bylaws. These Bylaws can be viewed at [www.ashcroftbc.ca/bylaws](http://www.ashcroftbc.ca/bylaws)
- The Village wrote a letter of support for the Village of Cache Creek as they apply for funding to extend the Cache Creek Airport runway.
- Council made a motion to donate \$500 to the City of Fort McMurray disaster to assist with recovery.
- Council provided a resolution of support for grant applications to develop a plan to update our development framework (Zoning, OCP and Subdivision bylaws).
- Council supported an application to Northern Development to fund upgrades to the HVAC at the Ashcroft Museum.
- Just a reminder that property taxes are due by 4:00 pm on July 15th, 2016 otherwise they will be subject to a 10% late penalty. The Village Office will remain open over the noon hour from July 4 to July 15 to accommodate those that need the lunch hour to pay their taxes. Post marks are not acceptable to meet the submission date.
- There will be a Regular meeting of Council on June 13th at 4:30 pm. June 27th, there will be a Committee of the Whole meeting at 6:00 pm and a Regular meeting of Council at 7:00 pm.
