

**THE CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF ASHCROFT**

**BYLAW NO. 762**

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A Bylaw to Utilize Municipal Ticket Information within the Municipality

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**WHEREAS** the *Community Charter*, including sections 260 to 273, empowers Council to, by bylaw, designate bylaws for which Municipal Ticket Information may be used as a means of bylaw enforcement, designate bylaw enforcement officers, and authorize the use of any word or expression on a Municipal Ticket Information to designate a bylaw offence,

**NOW THEREFORE** the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Village of Ashcroft in open meeting assembled, ENACTS THE FOLLOWING:

**Title**

1. This bylaw may be cited as the "Village of Ashcroft Ticket Information Utilization Bylaw No. 762, 2009".

**Bylaw enforced by ticket**

2. The bylaws and bylaw provisions listed in Column 1 of Schedule A may be enforced by means of a ticket in the form prescribed for the purpose of Section 264(1)(a) of the Community Charter.

**Bylaw enforcement officers**

3. The person appointed to, or who act in the job positions or titles listed in Column 2 of Schedule A are designated as Bylaw Enforcement Officers pursuant to Section 264(1)(b) of the Community Charter for the purpose of enforcing the Bylaws listed in Column 1 of Schedule A.

**Description of offences**

4. The words or expressions appearing in Column 1 of Schedule B designate the offences committed under the bylaw section numbers appearing in Column 2 of Schedule B opposite the respective words or expressions.

**Set Fines**

5. The amounts appearing in Column 3 of Schedule B are the fines set for the corresponding offences designated in Column 1 of Schedule B.

**Severability**

6. If any portion of this Bylaw is held invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, then that invalid portion shall be severed and the remainder of this Bylaw shall be deemed to have been adopted without the severed section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or phrase.
