Heritage Place Park is located at the southern end of Railway Avenue. Built in 1999 and 2000, it is a walk through time with story boards providing interesting facts about the history of Ashcroft. The park is also a tribute to our Japanese Sister City, Bifuka.

The park is currently undergoing some updating with the Village working cooperatively with the Communities in Bloom committee.

The peaceful setting is a favourite spot for outdoor weddings and family gatherings. During rodeo weekend it is not uncommon to see the Can Can girls performing in the gazebo.
