NOMINATION PACKAGES – GENERAL INFORMATION:

Nomination packages include a number of forms that must be completed and some require that they are signed in front of the Chief Election Officer, a Notary Public or a Commissioner for Taking Oaths within the Province of British Columbia. Please ensure that the documents are completed and filed by the deadline. Completed nomination forms may be faxed (250-453-9664) or emailed (michelle@ashcroftbc.ca) by 4:00 pm on Friday, September 14, 2018 however the originals must be received by 4:00 pm on Friday, September 21, 2018 for the nomination to be official. Failure to receive the original documents by the deadline will result in the nomination being refused.

Nomination & Information Package for Mayor or Councillor for Village of Ashcroft

Nominations must be made by a minimum of ten (10) qualified electors for the Village of Ashcroft.
