BYLAW NO. 789

A bylaw to amend the Village of Ashcroft Zoning Bylaw No 738, 2005

WHEREAS Council wishes to amend the Village of Ashcroft Zoning Bylaw No. 738;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Ashcroft, in open meeting assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. That the Village of Ashcroft Zoning Bylaw No. 738, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding the following:
 - a. Section 3.17 contained in Schedule A, attached to and forming a part of this Bylaw.
 - b. The definition for *Medical Marihuana Facility* contained in Schedule B, attached to and forming a part of this bylaw.
2. If any section, subsection sentence, clause or phrase of this Bylaw is for any reason held to be invalid by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, the invalid portion shall be severed and the part that is invalid shall not affect the validity of the remainder.
3. This Bylaw may be cited as "Village of Ashcroft Zoning Amendment Bylaw No. 789, 2014".

BYLAW NO. 789

“SCHEDULE A”

3.17 Medical Marihuana Production Facilities:

The cultivation, processing, drying, storing, packaging, distribution or testing of marihuana or medical marihuana is prohibited in all zones.

BYLAW NO. 789

“SCHEDULE B”

MARIHUANA means all parts of the genus cannabis whether growing or not and the seed or clone of such plants.

MEDICAL MARIHUANA means marihuana that is produced by a producer licenced by Health Canada and is prescribed by a medical professional for administration to treat or alleviate a qualifying patient's debilitating medical condition or symptoms associated with the patient's debilitating medical condition under the Marijuana Medical Access Regulations.
