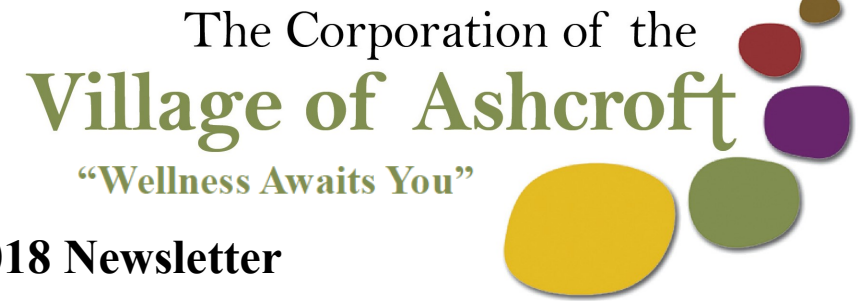

- Council resolved Mayor Jeyes to attend the Forest Sector Community Breakfast, hosted by the Thompson Rivers Natural Resource District on April 19, 2018
- Council resolved to observe June 2, 2018 as National Health and Fitness Day
