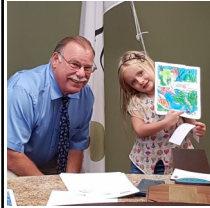

Community Update

Mayor Jeyes and Council would like to take a few minutes of your time to tell you about a number of things they have been working on as well as some community events:

- Council resolved to send Mayor Jeyes to address the DSCS 2018 graduating class.
- Council resolved to provide WRAPS \$500 to conduct Canada Day celebrations.
- Council resolved to provide free swimming on Canada Day for the hours between 1 and 4 pm.
- Council received a delegation of four Ashcroft youth who won free swim passes for their colouring skills in a Village-wide colouring contest.
- Council directed staff to investigate pressing projects that could be funded by the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program—Green Infrastructure.
- Council directed staff to request a member of the TNRD's Recycling Program staff to attend the July 14th Community BBQ to discuss changes to local recycling with residents of the community.
- The Mayor and Councilor Roden participated in a business walk on June 27.
- A public hearing was held on June 25 for public comment on the Zoning Bylaw Amendment No. 821, 2018
- Council gave final reading and adoption of Zoning Bylaw Amendment No. 821, and Business License Bylaw Amendment No. 820.
- Mayor Jeyes spoke at the Harmony Bell Unveiling Ceremony.
- Council resolved for the Village to apply for a grant to fund a feasibility study on the potential for a new hotel to be constructed within the Village.
- Council resolved to rent the Arena to the Ashcroft & District Fall Fair Association in order to hold the Fall Fair in early September.
- Council adopted the 2017 Annual Report; those interested may access it on the Village's Website.
- Council received a delegation and recommendations from the Official Community Plan Advisory Committee.
- Council received a delegation and the final report from the Off-Leash Dog Park Council Select Committee.
- Council received a delegation from the Ashcroft and District Curling Club.
- Council resolved to provide the Curling Club with a license to occupy for one year.

Era of Megafires is showing in Ashcroft on July 14.
