



COMMUNICATION BULLETIN

Consistent community updates regarding the status of the Tremont Cr. Wildfire will be as follows:

- Daily updates Monday - Friday by 1:30 pm on the Village Facebook Page, Website and poster at Post Office.
- After hours or weekend updates will only be posted when emergent information is received and must be communicated immediately to the public.
- Voyent Alerts will be sent for critical information only, not for daily fire status updates.

August 3, 2021 – UPDATE TREMONT CREEK (K218490)

- YD Ranch, Barnes Lake area and the Mesa subdivision, Barnes Street, Evans Road and properties along the east side of HWY 97C between Barnes Street and the Mesa remain on Evacuation Alert;
- An Evacuation Alert has been recommended and issued for Logan Lake as of July 30, 2021
- The current threat to Ashcroft remains minimal;
- Current estimated size is 27,624 hectares;
- Resources actioning the fire include: 33 firefighters, 7 helicopters and 35 pieces of heavy equipment. Additional assistance as needed from local First Nations, Ashcroft Fire Dept., and ranchers;
- The northern flank of the fire from Barnes Lake to Walhachin has very minimal to no observed fire activity;
- Along the west in the Barnes Lake area, mop up and patrol is occurring;
- Along the south at Glossy Mountain, crews are conducting planned hand and aerial ignitions to bring the fire down the existing guard;
- Construction and reinforcement of guards along the east and northeastern flanks will continue today. Guards have been completed along Glossy Mountain in the southwest flank using heavy equipment and planned ignitions will take place in this area today;

- An updated wildfire perimeter map of the Tremont Creek has been provided by BCWS and will be on display at the post office and updated as often as possible by BCWS.
