

Welcome to the Ashcroft Museum!

Please read before entering the Museum

Please refrain from visiting the Museum if you have experienced any of these symptoms in the last ten days: fever, chills, new or worsening cough, shortness of breath, sore throat and new muscle aches or headache.

Visitors will be required to:

1. Wear masks- If you do not have one, we will provide one for you
2. Use hand sanitizers upon entrance; provided for you inside
3. Follow arrows
4. Maintain required distance of 2 metres (6 feet)
5. Refrain from touching artifacts

Further information:

- No public washroom on site
- Children 12 and under must be accompanied by an adult
- We have small spaces in the Museum, if you find the front door locked it is because we are temporarily at capacity. This door will be open as soon as more space is available.
- Entrance is by donation- You will find a donation box to your left as you enter. We will not be handling cash so no change will be given, and there are no souvenirs or books being sold at this time.
- Staff will be frequently cleaning commonly touched surfaces, such as stair rails, display cases, etc.
- Please use the automatic door button on the left side of the door, with your elbow or knee to enter or leave the museum.
