



COMMUNICATION BULLETIN

This will be the last update from the Village in regards to the Tremont Creek fire. The fire is classed as “being held” by the BC Wildfire Service and is not threatening the community.

Being Held: Indicates that (with the resources currently committed to the fire) sufficient suppression action has been taken that the fire is not likely to spread beyond existing or predetermined boundaries under the prevailing and forecasted conditions.

September 1, 2021 – FINAL UPDATE TREMONT CREEK (K218490)

- Fire Status is ACTIVE but classed as BEING HELD
- All evacuation orders and alerts have been downgraded or rescinded
- Updated estimated size is 63,523 hectares;
- Resources continuing to action the fire include:
 - 161 firefighters
 - 5 assigned helicopters and 1 complex-shared helicopter
 - 18 pieces of heavy equipment.
 - 38 support personnel including the BCWS Incident Command Team
- Low level scanning is being utilized to identify hot spots.
- Rolling weather patterns, with cooler and wetter conditions, alternating with drying periods, has helped crews make good progress. However, fire behavior has shown increases in areas that are shaded, with fine fuels, or areas that have received minimal precipitation.;
- Crews and equipment will continue to monitor hot spots, focus on mop up and continue to construct guards for containment.

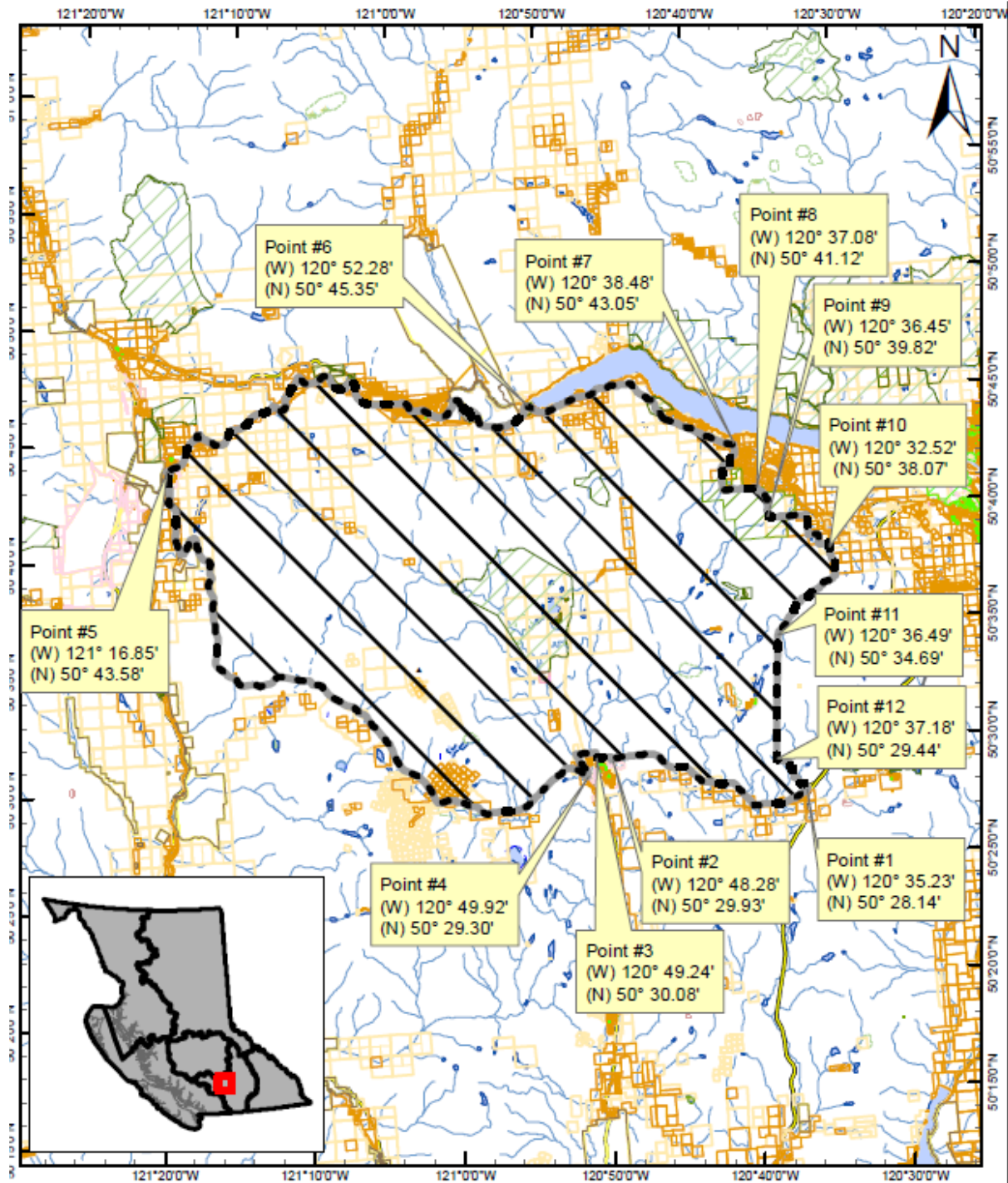

Area Restriction Map

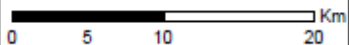
