I can be reached via email or by telephone at 250-571-9314. If the decision is in our favor, the cheque can be made out to "People of Pukaist".





A Canadian former professional ice hockey defenceman who played sixteen seasons in the National Hockey League (NHL), last suiting up for the Toronto Maple Leafs. He is an NHL All-Star and Olympic Gold Medalist.



Eric Brewer born in Vernon, BC, and raised in Ashcroft BC (began playing ice hockey in the Ashcroft Minor Hockey program) has represented Canada at eight International Ice Hockey Federation – sanctioned events, winning three Ice Hockey World Championships gold medals and one World Cup of Hockey gold medal. He won his Olympic gold medal during the 2002 Winter Olympics. For this accomplishment, he was inducted into the BC Sports Hall of Fame with his British Columbian teammates in 2003.

SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR FUNDING – GOLD COUNTRY FAM TOUR LUNCHEON

Background

Gold Country Communities Society (GCCS) organizes an annual FAM tour that features a different community or region every year. The FAM tour brings together tourist information personnel as well as various operators and allows them to become familiar with services, attractions and events that are held in the featured area. The Village of Ashcroft has been chosen for the 2019 tour.

Discussion

GCCS is funded by each community and regional district area through a tax requisition by the Thompson Nicola Regional District. They does not charge for the participants of the FAM tour. The last time that the Village hosted the event I believe that we provided a snack at the museum for the participants. This year the Village is being asked to provide \$250 to sponsor the lunch for this event. This function has not been budgeted for in the 2019 financial plan unless Council chooses to provide a Grant-In-Aid. The request did not include the grant application and required documentation. The CFO advises that this event could be covered under the Public Relations account.

Recommendation

Administration advises that Council has two options for this request:

- a. That the Village of Ashcroft provide funding to Gold Country Communities Society in the amount of \$250 to sponsor the 2019 FAM tour luncheon with costs to be applied to the Public Relations account. Or
- b. That the Village of Ashcroft deny the request from Gold Country Communities Society to sponsor the 2019 FAM tour luncheon in the amount of \$250.
