Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by the Chair at 9:30 am

1. Discussion

- **Update: Speed Bumps and Signage**
 - Speed Bumps and signage have been installed on Ranch Road. Yellow triangles have been painted on each speed bump.

- **Update: 30kmh Speed Limit**
 - Discuss speed limit through town as per survey that was done; to be taken to a Town Hall Meeting
 - Brian indicated complaints that there was only one 30kmh sign at one end of Tingley Street.
 - Complaints of speeders along Tingley Street
 - Street Safety WG will recommend to Council that a Town Hall Meeting be scheduled in November. Topics of discussion will be 30kmh speed limit & water meters, as well as other updates

- **Update: LED Speed Zone Signs**
 - Discuss locations to set up these signs
 - Signs have arrived. Daniela will look into specifics of the funding applications for locations of the signs.
 - Potential post placement for the signs:
 - 2 – Mesa Vista Dr.: 1 above apartments facing northeast near Juniper Dr. & Mesa Vista Dr. and 1 near Cliff Cres. & Semlin Dr. facing southwest
 - 1 – Railway Ave.: 1 entrance to Heritage Park facing northeast
 - 1 – Evans Rd.: 1 about half way down Evans; providing direction change on one post is feasible instead of installing 2 posts
 - 1 – Tingley St.: middle of Tingley providing direction change on one post is feasible instead of installing 2 posts

- 2 - Government St.: middle of park area and near beginning of Ranch Rd.
- 1 - Elm St. near Pine & Elm Streets.
- 8 posts to install

- **Parking between 6th and 7th Streets on Railway Ave.**
 - Street Safety WG to recommend to Council that 2 Hour Maximum Parking signs from 8 am to 8 pm be posted in front of 605 & 611 Railway Avenue on both sides of Railway Ave.

- **Parking on 3rd Street across from the Liquor Store**
 - The deck of a flat deck tow truck parks on 3rd St. and it is sticking too far out on to the street creating a safety concern for persons driving down 3rd. The BEO will be advised to have a conversation with owner regarding this issue.

- **Request from Villa Fronterra Strata for parking at the end of Brink St.**
 - They would like to remove a portion of cedar hedge to make room for parking. This is not an ideal area to develop new parking spaces.
 - After discussing this, it was agreed that Daniela will write a letter to suggest Villa Fronterra develop a parking lot off the end of Brink St near their gazebo

- **Update: Willow Grove Apartment Request for Angular Parking on Government Street**
 - No reply from Willow Grove regarding angular parking along Government St.
 - Brian will send a letter to Willow Grove Strata advising we have not heard from them further regarding angular parking, and that the letter will include that if we do not hear from them before the end of 2025 then we will close the file.

- Daniela to write a letter to Villa Fronterra to suggest developing a parking lot off the end of Brink St. near their gazebo.

- Brian to send a letter to Willow Grove Apts. advising if we have not heard from them by the end of 2025 regarding angular parking along Govt. St. then we will close the file.
