Pursuant to Section 108 of the Local Government Act and Section 6(a) of the Village of Ashcroft Local Government Elections and Other Voting Procedures Bylaw No. 853, 2022, notice is hereby given that the Chief Election Officer has established an additional advance voting opportunity to assist residents of local long-term care and seniors' facilities in casting their vote in the 2025 Ashcroft Municipal By-Election.

This opportunity is provided to ensure that residents who may experience challenges attending a regular voting place are able to participate in the election.

### ELIGIBILITY TO VOTE

All qualified electors of the Village of Ashcroft may vote at this advance voting opportunity. Voters must meet the following requirements:

- Be 18 years of age or older on General Voting Day (October 18, 2025);
- Be a Canadian citizen;
- Have lived in British Columbia for at least six months immediately before registering;
- Have lived in, or be a registered owner of real property in, the Village of Ashcroft for at least 30 days immediately before registering; and
- Not be disqualified under the Local Government Act or any other enactment.

Please bring two pieces of identification that provide your name and address.
