## THE CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF ASHCROFT

## **BYLAW NO. 684**

Being a bylaw for the Corporation of the Village of Ashcroft to amend the Village of Ashcroft Noise Control Bylaw No. 423, 1983

The Council for the Corporation of the Village of Ashcroft, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

- That Bylaw No. 423, cited as "The Corporation of the Village of Ashcroft Noise Control Bylaw No. 423, 1983" is hereby amended as follows:
- That under Section B (General Regulations) the following new wording be added:
  - 6. The provisions of this part shall not apply or be enforced against:
    - a. "Any business or industry carried on in those areas of the Village designated as Light Industrial Zone (M1) or Heavy Industrial Zone (M2) pursuant to the provisions of the Ashcroft Zoning Bylaw and Amendments thereto, with respect to noise that is reasonably or necessarily incidental to the business or industry, providing that the Village Council may require that any such business or industry shall be conducted within a closed building where possible."
    - b. "Any construction, building, demolition, excavating, grading or other kind of construction or destruction work carried on with the written permission of Council or of any Provincial or Federal Government regulating agency."
    - c. "Any agriculture carried on in those areas of the Village designated as Agricultural Zone pursuant to the provisions of the Ashcroft Zoning Bylaw and Amendments thereto, with respect to noise that is reasonably or necessarily incidental to agriculture, providing that the Village Council may require that any such agricultural activity shall be conducted within a closed building if possible."
- This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "The Corporation of the Village of Ashcroft Noise Control Amending Bylaw No. 684, 2000".
