1. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Roden called the meeting to order at 4:30 pm

2. WELCOME

Mayor Roden welcomed everyone to the Town Hall meeting and turned the meeting over the CFO Bhalla.

3. 2020 AUDITED FINANCIAL STATEMENTS & 2022-2026 FIVE YEAR FINANCIAL PLAN

CFO Bhalla presented a summary of the 2021 audited financial statements as well as the proposed five-year plan, 2022-2026(inclusive).

CFO Bhalla commented this meeting fulfills the statutory annual financial meeting requirements, also commenting municipalities are required by the Community Charter to have a balanced budget. CFO Bhalla was pleased to announce that the Village has received a clear audit from Grant Thornton LLP highlighting asset values and liabilities.

Ashcrofts budgets are broken into four funds:

- 1. Operational Fund
- 2. Water Fund
- 3. Sewer Fund
- 4. Reserves

CFO Bhalla discussed revenues, expenses, restricted assets, tangible capital assets and reserves. CFO Bhalla itemized expenses by category and broke down how the revenues were spent.



Taxation concerns have been received at the Village office and CFO Bhalla provided clarification as to how the 2.5% increase in Ashcroft's tax rate is calculated and how this is affected by the increase in property values from BC Assessment.

4. COMMENTS AND QUESTIONS FROM THE PUBLIC

Mayor Roden opened the floor

Cam Tedford - Ashcroft Clarification requested in regards to the amortization line item in the budget; Comment regarding the 2.5% tax increase; Clarity requested in regards to the 5 year financial plan relating to the proposed reservoir project and the grant funding required;

Mayor Roden thanked CFO Bhalla for the excellent presentation and adjourned the meeting at 5:00 pm.
