

## Community Update

Mayor Jeyes and Council would like to take a few minutes of your time to tell you about a number of things they have been working on as well as some past community events:

- Council met with MLA Jackie Tegart to discuss local issues.
- Council received a delegation from Santo Talarico regarding sign restrictions in the new proposed Zoning and OCP Bylaws.
- Council received a presentation from Yogi Bhalla, CFO, on the Asset Management program he is developing.
- Council resolved to provide a grant-in-aid of \$500 to the Ashcroft & District Fall Fair Society.
- Council resolved to provide the use of the Heritage Place Park Gazebo for the Terry Fox Run
- Council resolved to provide a letter of support toward the TNRD's application for funding to build a new Recycling Depot to serve Ashcroft and Cache Creek.
- Council resolved to have Mayor Jeyes and Councilor Trill to attend the Canadian Red Cross *Managing the New Normal* presentation at the UBCM Conference in Whistler.
- Council authorized staff to submit a funding request to the Federation of Canadian Municipalities to continue asset management efforts.
- Council authorized staff to submit an application for funding to replace Lift Station No.1
- Council authorized staff to proceed with a program to address the invasive *Tree of Heaven* found in our community.
- Council instructed staff to proceed with an application for the Evacuation Route Planning Grant offered by the Union of British Columbia Municipalities (UBCM).

### Residents are to now bring recyclables to the Cache Creek Transfer Station

The recycling depot located on Railway Avenue is now closed and no longer operational. Residents of Ashcroft and surrounding area are required to bring all of their recycling to the Cache Creek Transfer Station. Here are a few tips that are good to know before you go:

- Recycling can only be dropped off when the Transfer Station is open (Wed through Sun).
- Containers need to be clean of food residue and contaminates.
- There are five streams of recyclables that items must be sorted into, they include:
  - \* Cardboard and paper
  - \* Metal and tin
  - \* Plastic bags and overwrap
  - \* White and coloured Styrofoam
  - \* Glass bottles and Jars
